Killions Café on the Square in downtown Columbia is known for great sandwiches and gourmet coffee, but what you probably didn't know is it also houses a radio station. 910 The Duck is an AM radio station that also streams its content on the internet and the studio is right inside the café: Killion's Radio Café!

About 4 months ago Chuck Killion approached us about doing an hour-long radio program about the jail ministry. Having never done anything like this I figured why not? Chaplain Lynn and I picked a few program themes, jotted down some notes, and jumped into radio with both feet. The hour seemed to fly by and it was really fun.

**JAIL TIME RADIO** airs every Tuesday from noon to one. Our goal is to inform listeners about a wide variety of topics including jail life, addictions, domestic violence, and the justice system. We begin every program with the disclaimer that we are not professional therapists, doctors, or lawyers and the topics covered are for discussion purposes only. We seek to inform, educate, and encourage those who have friends or loved ones that are incarcerated. Interviews are really interesting and on previous shows we've interviewed attorneys, School Resource Officers, CASA staff, domestic violence class instructors, and former inmates.

Chaplain Lynn and I consider the radio program an extension of the jail ministry by informing and encouraging the listeners who undoubtedly know of someone who has been incarcerated or currently incarcerated. Also, many friends have commented that we have the perfect faces for radio!

At a recent retreat at my church I heard the phrase, “Lips speak to lips and hearts speak to hearts.” I think this phrase sums up the work of Maury Chaplain Ministries.
